

Sanford's Pond Safety Guidelines

- No skating until CRC has announced that the ice is safe and when the "Skating" sign is facing the road.
- Please treat Sanford's Pond, shed and equipment with respect
- Children under the age of 11 may not be dropped off at the pond without a parent or previously arranged supervision
- A CRC designated chaperone must be present in order for skating to be open....NEVER skate alone
- Please store all equipment neatly away after use and before leaving
- Please use the shovels for snow removal ONLY
- Please abide by the skating/no skating sign
- The skate sharpener may only be operated by someone designated by the CRC to do so
- Always look where you are going! Please no headphones or cell phones on the ice.
- Please dress appropriately; everyone under the age of 18 must wear a helmet if holding a hockey stick
- Hockey sticks must be swung below the waist
- Please rest when you are tired or cold
- Use of foul language and/or aggressive behavior, drugs, alcohol or cigarettes is strictly prohibited
- All skaters must agree to abide by these guidelines and must have a signed waiver on file
