the September Mystery Photo! Frank D. Bennett was the brother of Mike's great grandfather, Will Bennett. The store was located next to Mark McGee's house on South Road. It closed after Frank died in 1920 at age 41 - leaving a widow and several children. His store was moved across the road and became Elliot Hawkes cottage. His widow, Trudy, retired there. She and her second husband, Roger Burrill expanded the cottage and winterized it. Frank Bennett has several living descendants including his grandchildren CIHS members, Sylvia Ross, Joyce Burns, Patty Emerson and Theron Hamilton.
