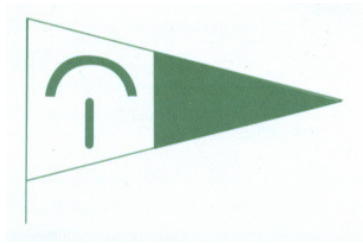

## ***Chebeague Island Yacht Club Sponsored Events***

**The summer season usually starts on the 4<sup>th</sup> of July weekend with the Opening Race and, later that weekend, the Commodore's Reception.**

**Other races held during the July and August season include, but are not limited to, the Crow Island Race (following the Crow Island picnic), Ocean Race, Hamilton Beach Race (rafting party follows), Indian Point Race, Double Race I, Round Island Race, Bates Island Race (following the Bates Island picnic), and the Double Race II.**

**For the Power boaters, there are a Power Night and a Power Lunch.**

**The Chebeague Island Community Sailing School (CICSS) sponsors two 2-week (Mondays through Fridays) Sailing School sessions . For more experienced or older persons, CICSS offers a 5-week session.**

**The season concludes on the Labor Day weekend with the Annual Meeting / Commodore's Reception.**

# *Yachting Protocol*

Safety at sea shall be the first priority to be observed by the members, both for their own yacht and the yachts of others. Coast Guard Auxiliary examinations are recommended.

Yachts joining or departing the Fleet on a Club cruise should advise the Fleet Captain or Senior Flag Officer present of its intentions. This is especially important for safety reasons for the departing yacht.

When joining a raft, request permission from the anchor boat and follow directions as to location indicated by anchor boat. Have bow, stern and bow spring lines ready to pass.

Departing a raft, advise the anchor boat. Leaving from inside a raft, back out, but first pass the bow line from the boat on one side to the boat on the opposite side.

The yacht joining a raft should have 2 large fenders (minimum) hung prior to approach. The bow and stern lines should be made up with loops to pass to raft allowing adjustment to be made by the approaching crew. Spring lines fore and aft are very important since they control position of rafting boat. They should be ready to go as soon as possible after bow and stern lines are secured.

## *Flag Etiquette Guide*

Flag	Time flown	Placement under sail or power
Yacht Ensign	0800 to Sundown	Stern staff (under sail option: 2/3 up leech from the clew of main or mizzen)
National Ensign	0800 to Sundown	Same as above
State Flag	0800 to Sundown	Masthead or starboard spreader
Club Burgee	Day and Night	Power - bow staff Sail - masthead or starboard spreader

## *SAILING SCHOOL REGULATIONS*

**The boats and equipment assigned the sailing school belong to the total membership of the Chebeague Island Yacht Club.**

**The use of the boats are restricted to students whose fees are paid in full, instructors, the school director and those the director authorizes at his or her own discretion. At all times the boats and equipment are the full responsibility of the Sailing School Director.**

**Insurance for boats and equipment will be carried by the Chebeague Island Yacht Club as part of the budget of the sailing school. The amount of such insurance will be determined by the Yacht Club Board of Directors.**
