On April 27, 2022, the ConnectMaine Authority voted to approve our grant request for \$800,000 in funding to be matched by as much as \$975,000 as authorized by Town Meeting in December, 2021, by a vote of 84 in favor to 18 opposed.

Of the eight (8) awards made out of 23 applying towns or groups of towns, Chebeague was #1.

Here's the official notification

At the June 11, 2022 Town Meeting with about 70 resident citizens in attendance, the broadband contracts passed easily,

all in favor, save 7 opposed to the Construction Contract and 4 opposed to the Franchise Contract.

That is 90% and 94%, respectively, in favor of the broadband contracts. Thus, the citizens of Chebeague Island voted overwhelmingly to make make broadband service available to

every home on the Island with no increase in property taxes as a result.

On s February 23, 2023 the ConnectMaine Authority increased the grant funding by \$170,00 to \$970,000

in recognition of a switch from State to Federal funding and several unanticipated expenses.

This website seeks to inform our voters about what true broadband internet is and how it can enrich our community.
