What is I LEAD-Nonprofits?

I LEAD is a 3-day leadership training program for island and remote coastal nonprofit leaders and board members. The program is designed to bring participants together to develop leadership and business management skills and create a professional network of island nonprofit leaders. The program will teach skills necessary to manage a successful nonprofit such as:

- Articulation of organizational mission, vision and values
- Fundraising and grant application strategies
- Meeting facilitation training
- Strategic planning training
- Board recruitment and development
- Creating a sustainable budget and endowment



What are the training dates and time commitments?

I LEAD is a 3-day training program that runs from noon on January 8th through noon on January 10th.

Who should attend?

This training is designed for directors, officers and board members of island and remote coastal nonprofit organizations.

How much does it cost?

The fee for the training is \$100 per participant. The Island Institute will be covering the remaining costs, including hotel and meals. If you wish to stay in a single room, there is a \$50 additional fee. Scholarships are available.

How do I apply?
