Dear Chebeague Island Boater:

The Town of Cumberland and the Chebeague Island Transition Team have agreed to bring to the Chebeague Island Town Meeting on July 1, 2007 a proposal to split the fees for the moorings and the stone wharf tie-ups 50/50.

The Town of Cumberland will send the Town of Chebeague a check for 50% of the fees collected as of July 1, 2007. It is important to register your mooring and get your boat assignment for the upcoming season. If you have any questions, please contact my office or speak with one of the Transition Team representatives about the revenue sharing proposal.

The Town of Cumberland will be monitoring the Stone Wharf until July 1, 2007. The Harbormaster's boat will be staying with Chebeague Island after July 1.

We anticipate installing all of the floats back in the water sometime in the month of March, weather permitting.

### Stone Wharf - Float Tie-up Allocation

The Town of Cumberland shall conduct a selection process for the allocation of tie—up spaces along the Stone Wharf Float System at Chebeague Island.

#### Space Allocation shall be as follows:

- Maximum of 50 spaces
- Boats will be placed in designated areas per Attachment B of the Ordinance.
- Boats with a paid mooring permit, boat registration, or both, will be eligible for selection. Non-residents and boats not presently moored at the Stone Wharf will be eligible when all spaces have not been allocated.

Applications will be randomly drawn in a public meeting at Town Hall, 290 Tuttle Road, Cumberland, Maine. The drawing shall be March 30, 2007.

#### Required Materials:

- 1. Paid Mooring Permit for the upcoming season
- 2. Check for cost of Float Space (\$50-under 12' or \$125-12' to 17' for residents) (\$75 or \$150 non- residents)
- 3. Proof of current Boat Registration
- 4. Daytime or Emergency Contact Telephone Number
- 5. Mooring Permit No. and Owner's Name
- 6. Completed Application mailed to the Town Office by March 29<sup>th</sup>

#### **After Selection:**

- Areas will be assigned in order of preference as selected on your application.
  No Changes can be made after Assignments have been made.
- You will be notified by mail of your assignment.
- Areas shall be designated by color:

Float E F G H – Area 1	14' up to 17'
Float I & H – Area 2	14' to 17'
Float J – Area 3	12' to 14'
Float B – Area 4	12' and under


Spaces will be designated by AREA ONLY (not as a slip)
