REMINDER FOR NEW BOAT REGISTRATIONS: If you are registering a newly purchased boat please be sure to bring the bill of sale to the Town of North Yarmouth who is temporarily processing Chebeague boat registrations. They will also be collecting Maine sales tax. If you had a boat previously registered it will also facilitate the new boat's registration if you bring along the VIN number from the old boat. Don't forget, you must come first to the Chebeague Town office to pay your excise taxes.

NEW CAR REGISTRATIONS & TITLE TRANSFERS: Please come into the office on Thursdays from 1-4pm and see Cheryl Buxbaum. All other re-registrations can be done at anytime that the town office is open.

AUGUST SHELLFISH LICENSES: Will be available on a first-come first-serve basis starting **Thursday, August 2, from 12 pm to 8 pm.**

MOORING PERMITS: The Town of Cumberland will issue these permits until 12-31-07.

FISHING/HUNTING LICENSES: Office staff are being trained in Orono this week as so we are still unable to process these licenses. Stay tuned!
