Topic: FY26 Budget Priorities Discussion

Purpose: Identify possible budget priorities for the coming fiscal year

Date: January 7th, 2025

Background:

The purpose of this discussion is to identify possible budget priorities for the next fiscal year (2025-2026) and review the budget development timeline.

The following are anticipated changes in expenditures and revenues for the next fiscal year:

- Expenditures
 - Debt Service costs: Budgeted \$107,923 for FY25. Anticipate that FY26 will be a reduced and final payment.
 - Special education tuition reduction: Budgeted \$57,740 for FY25 and anticipate this being reduced significantly for FY26.
 - Special education staffing increase: Anticipate increases in ed tech staffing (1 FTE) and related service providers for FY26.
- Revenues
 - Tuition revenue: currently anticipate \$40,000 of revenue to include.

Other points of discussion or consideration include:

- Staffing plan for 2025-2026, including the new structure for Superintendent and Principal/Lead Teacher
- Capital costs or investments for 2025-2026
- Staff needs (ie technology, books, supplies)

- March 4th: Town Budget Workshop (5:30-6:00pm)
