Welcome to your first newsletter of the 2009-10 school year. At the end of each week I will report on group presentations, current themes, and any special events.

Yellow folders will come home on Friday's and should be returned to school on Monday or the first day back the following week. The folders may include notes from administration or me as well as works your child did and wanted to save and bring home.

Our remodeled space, is working well and the returning students have easily adjusted to the physical changes. It is nice not to have so many other things stored in the classroom making all areas accessible to them.

There are three daily jobs - fish care, line leader, and snack helper. Jobs will be posted on Monday and they will keep that job for the entire week. Soon each child will also have their own plant for which they will be responsible.

These first few weeks the focus is on establishing a positive classroom environment where they all feel comfortable with one another and with the freedoms and limits of the classroom. On Thursday we established two classroom rules: Be nice and be safe.

 Friday's second circle was our first peace circle. We talked about the moon and read a poem.


